PRACTICE PEN RULES

PRESERVE A LOPING TRACK IN THE PRACTICE PEN AT ALL TIME

- Stay to the inside of the group if you wish to go slow,
- Stay to the outside if you wish to go fast.

PRACTICE PEN IS RESTRICTED TO HORSES ENTERED IN THE SHOW

- Horses not entered in the show are prohibited from the enclosed practice pen or area where horses enter into the competition ring.

DRY WORK SHOULD ONLY BE DONE IN AN AREA WHERE THERE IS NOT TRAFFIC

ENTERING AND LEAVING THE PEN

- When entering the Practice pen yield to all horses in motion.
- Enter the stream of horse traffic from the outside in the same direction as the group and look around before leaving the group to avoid contact with another horse.
- Never stop in traffic.
- Do not weave in and out of traffic and avoid contact with other horses. Maintain a constant speed in your position.
- Change directions and maintain the flow in one direction when asked. Always ask when you wish to change direction.
- Yield to all vehicles, pedestrians or horses wishing to enter or exit the Practice area.

RIDERS MUST BE IN CONTROL OF THEIR HORSE AT ALL TIMES

- Horses cannot be led from another horse in the Practice area.
- If you must tie your horse, tie them to a secure fence, not panels, in areas with no traffic. Do not tie stallions, kicking or biting horses in the Practice pen.
- Do not ride under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

ALL COMPETITORS & LOPERS MUST FOLLOW A.R.H. ATTIRE RULES WHILE IN THE PRACTICE PEN

- Anyone entering the Practice Pen or Show Arena must wear Cowboy Hat or Safety Helmet, Button up Long Sleeve Shirt, Cowboy Boots.
- Helmets must be worn by persons under the age of 18 if they are not a member of the **A.R.H.** or if they are competing at the show.
- All horses must be ridden in approved **A.R.H.** Equipment while in the Practice area.
- No training devices allowed.
- Apply boots and groom in areas with no traffic.
